He is the author of “The Myth of Solid Ground: Earthquakes, Prediction, and the Fault Line Between Reason and Faith” (Viking, 2004; Penguin, 2005), which was selected as a Best Book of 2004 by the San Francisco Chronicle and the Chicago Tribune, and the editor of “Another City: Writing from Los Angeles” (City Lights, 2001) and “Writing Los Angeles: A Literary Anthology” (Library of America, 2002), which received a 2002 California Book Award. His work has appeared in The Atlantic Monthly, The Nation, The New York Times Book Review, LA Weekly, Los Angeles, and on National Public Radio’s All Things Considered. His essay “The Half-Birthday of the Apocalypse” was nominated for a 2004 Pushcart Prize. From 2000 to 2005, he taught in the MFA in Creative Writing Program at Antioch University Los Angeles.
